

# Goose in the Corner Supply List

## **Fabric:**

To make a large throw, approximately 50 x 70, you will need 4 yds of background fabric and 1 ½ yds for the corners. If you want to have multi-colored corners, then plan on 6 – 12 fat quarters. The more the better.

## **Fabric selection**

You can use a small print for the center of the block and pull colors from the print for the corners. You can use a blender fabric for the background and a strong contrast for the points. Play with it, keeping in mind large prints are not what you want for this experiment.

Note: All cutting will be done in class. This class focuses on designing your quilt – lots of options for layout, size, etc. which Bobbie will discuss in class.

You will be provided with many worksheets to help you work through designing your quilt.

## **Other Supplies:**

- Machine and usual sewing tools
  - Don't' forget the power cord, feet and electrical items.
- Rotary mat and cutter.
- Ruler to cut strips.
  - If you have a square ruler 8-10 inches or so, it will be helpful.
- Marking pencil that will show on the back side of your corners.
- Some coloring tool, e.g., colored pencils, fine-line highlighters. These will be used as you design your quilt; anywhere from 1-12 will help.
- Notebook or something to take notes.
