All levels

1 day

Get those UFOs out of hiding and bring them to class. Half-finished tops, orphan blocks and things you'll never finish as they are. Make your rotary cutter into a magic wand, as you slice, dice, add strips, and completely transform those stalled projects into beautiful blocks and quilts you never imagined you could make. Total fun!

**one-day class lets you transform blocks; two-day class is great for reinventing a quilt top.*

- Any of these: Partially pieced or unfinished tops, orphan blocks from exchanges, block of the month,,or vintage blocks you don't know what to do with. Leftover squares and strips of any color or size. Experiments that didn't work, blocks that didn't fit, or you thought were just plain ugly. You get the picture!
- 2 yards or more TOTAL of assorted 2-1/2" strips or fat/skinny eighths, quarters, in wide range of color, pattern, and value. (lights/mediums/darks/stripes/solids/prints -
- *** black & white prints and solids are especially good!*
- Sewing machine, thread
- Rotary cutter & mat
- Scissors, seam ripper
- Sewing machine
- Neutral thread
- Iron
- Ruler

- 24" x 36" piece of cotton batting for a design wall.
- Blue painter's tape to put up design wall.
