## 2024 RODEO CHALLENGE Revised Rules (changes noted in Red) August 22, 2023

# Based on membership feedback, these are the revised rules for this Challenge. Our intent is to encourage more participation with additional options to participate with more chances to win!

The inspiration for this Challenge comes from an old poster from a rodeo circa 1930's. Imagine you are at the National Rodeo Finals here in Las Vegas. See the bronco riders straining to stay on their bucking broncos; watch the speed of calf roping; see how quickly cowboys wrestle steers to the ground; watch how long cowboys stay on bucking bulls; or how fast they race their horses around barrels.

### **Rules:**

- You will need to utilize the bandana fabric supplied in your packet visible on the front of your project (no substitutions), and a picture of one rodeo event utilized somewhere in your project either pieced, painted, appliqued or embroidered. Quilt size may not exceed 160 linear inches (40x40); table runners may be of any length. To determine the size of your item, add up the lengths of all four sides this should not exceed 160.
- The first viewing of any submission must be at the 2024 Third Quarterly Meeting where the Challenge items are displayed for viewing and voting purposes. It is your responsibility to keep your entry secret. These items should not be submitted to 12-4-12 until after they are displayed at the Third Quarterly Meeting. Items entered in any quilt show or event prior to the Third Quarterly Meeting will be disqualified.
- Entries must be prepared by the person submitting it. Any entry regardless of category can be quilted by someone other than the maker. The design & style of construction of your item will determine the category of your entry. It does not need to be entered into the Group category.
- Bind as you choose. No framed items accepted.
- Entries will be hung using pins; you may add tabs for us to pin through.

#### **Categories:**

- 1. 100% pieced.
- 2. 100% applique.
- 3. Mixed combination of pieced, applique and/or embroidery
- 4. Circle Group any entry submitted by a DQN Circle and designated as such
- 5. Group any entry worked on by 2 or more members done separate from a specific DQN Circle
- 6. Off the wall any entry that is not a traditional bed or wall quilt. For instance, clothing, table runner, bags, doll
- 7. Small –any small quilt: between 12" to 24" or 20" square; includes miniatures
- 8. First entry –first time entry in the Challenge by a current member
