


## Bobbie Stember's Our Heart to Yours

**Please be consistent per block or quilt in your light and dark shades. If only making blocks please use reds as your darks and white or creams as your lights. Can be scrappy, 4 reds per block but please use the same light per block. If possible use the same light per top. Thank you for participating!**

Yardage for one Block: 8 ½" unfinished, 8" finished:

Light 1-5" square &  
4-1 ½" squares

Dark: 1-5" square &  
2-4 ½" squares



43" X 63" Lap/Crib quilt  
Yardage for 20 blocks (4 X 6)  
Background Hearts: 1 yard  
Hearts 1 ½ yds or scraps =  
1 ½ yds.  
Cornerstones 1/3 yard  
Sashing 1 ¼ Yard

### CUTTING FROM YARDAGE

6 strips wof 5"    Dark Fabric  
6 strips wof 4.5"    Dark Fabric  
8 strips wof 5"    Background  
6 strips wof 1.5"    Background  
4 strips wof 2.5"    Cornerstone  
14 strips wof 2.5"    Sashing

43" X 43" Baby/Toddler Quilt  
Yardage for 16 blocks (4 X 4)  
Background hearts ¾ yards  
Hearts 1 ¼ yds or scraps =  
1 ¼ yds.  
Cornerstones ¼ yard  
Sashing 1 yard

### CUTTING FROM YARDAGE


4 strips wof 5"    Dark Fabric  
4 strips wof 4.5"    Dark Fabric  
4 strips wof 5"    Background  
4 strips wof 1.5"    Background  
2 strips wof 2.5"    Cornerstone  
7 strips wof 2.5"    Sashing

### Floating Heart Variation:

You won't need to use corner stones in this variation. Add cornerstone, sashing, and heart background yardage together. Half of your sashing strips will be 2 ½" X 10 ½ ". Use this sashing strip vertically. Otherwise sewing instructions are the same. When finished your hearts should appear to be "floating" on your background fabric.

## SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

### LOWER PORTION OF BLOCK




Take 1 Light 5" square and 1 Dark 5" square put right sides together, draw a straight line on the diagonal-may mark this using your favorite method. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from drawn line on both sides of the line; cut on line, you should have two half square triangle blocks. Square each block down to  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ". Press towards the darker side. Put right sides together and sew together. Press towards the right darker fabric. Should measure  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " X  $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".




### TOP PORTION OF THE BLOCK

Take one  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Dark block put a  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Light square on the top right or left side, draw a diagonal line sew on this line, flip, check position of lighter square. You may have to redo to make this a square, press towards the dark, trim seam to  $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Repeat on other side; then do again with the other dark and light squares.






Put right sides together of both pieces, sew together, press. Should measure  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " X  $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".




## PUTTING THE BLOCK TOGETHER

Now put both 4 ½" X 8 ½" pieces together and sew a horizontal seam be sure to nest center seams, iron (press) this should make one unfinished 8 ½" heart (Finishes) at 8".




## MAKING AND APPLYING THE SASHING

If making this quilt; sashing looks great and it takes less blocks to increase the size of the quilt! Sashing per block: you'll need 2 light or dark - 2 ½" X 8 ½" strips with one 2 ½" cornerstone. If using light strips we recommend using a dark corner stones, reverse for dark strips, sew a sashing strip to the top of a block. Attach a cornerstone to a vertical sashing piece and sew onto the right side of the block. Do this for all of your blocks. Sew your blocks together. Only the left side and bottom will need sashing and corner stones to become a quilt top. Do that, then sandwich, quilt, bind and label as desired!
