

I SPY BABY QUILT

Supplies:

13-15 Novelty Fabrics - Fat Quarters - you will cut two shapes of each fabric making "matching pairs"

1 yard background fabric for the letter blocks – one letter per block. Suggestions:

-tone on tone, white, cream, gray, or other bright solid color of your choice

The alpha blocks can be cut using the accuquilt machine. Alternately, they can be made using your embroider machine. Alphabet files will be provided for those wanting to use their embroidery machine to create these– **bring a flash drive** that is compatible with your embroidery machine.

1 yard fabric of your choice for border and binding

Accuquilt Go – Tumbler 6 ½" Die – Chris will have her die and machine for students to use or you can bring your own.

Embroidery Sewing Machine with a hoop 5x7 or larger – if choosing to embroider your letter blocks

Stabilizer like OESD Stabil Stick or comparable product that is self sticking. You will need 26 pieces – one for each letter. Do to the enclosed classroom we will not be unable to use 505 Temporary Spray

Matching Thread for piecing

A variety of colorful embroidery thread for lettering the individual blocks

Bobbin Thread such as Bottom Line or thread of your choice.

All regular sewing supplies, scissors, bobbins, needles for embroidery and for piecing.

Optional:

Cutting mat and rotary cutter
Iron and ironing mat.
