

# Crossed Heart Quilt – 12 squares

40" x 50.5"

## **1. Supply list:**

**a. 12-10" squares of background fabric – need minimum 4 different colors for a 12 block quilt. I used 12 different colors in one and four in the other.**

**b. 12-9" squares of assorted red, red print or pink for hearts.**

**c. Scraps of black –white for crosses on hearts.**

**d. ½ yard of a different solid black or red or black/white for sashing and ½-¾ yard for borders.**

**e. 1/3 yard of a different black/white or red for binding**

**f. template: will provide template in class which is 8 ¼ wide at widest point**

**g. Fusible for hearts – I like Soft Fuse(Shades Textiles).**

**h. Stabilizer to applique hearts – I like Totally Stable by Sulky but freezer paper will work also.**

**i. . All basic sewing supplies including rotary cutter, mat, sewing machine etc.**

**j. Decorative thread to match heart which will be appliqued.**
