Description & Supply List

There are many ways of making waterfalls – this class lets you play with most of those ways, using very cool stuff to create your little landscape using MistyFuse, metallic paint powders, Lutradur, Puff Paint, Tyvek, fabric paints, iridescent cracked ice, painted melted cellophane, sheer fabrics, roving, Angelina and Tintzl fibers and more. You will come away with a small, landscape art piece pinned and ready to sew, and lots of inspiration for new projects.

Kit fee (required) of \$20 includes full instructions and pattern, Puff Painted tree and rocks, Tyvek; iridescent cracked ice; Mistyfuse; Lutradur; Angelina fiber, cellophane; and use of fabric paints, metallic paint powders, fine iridescent glitter and Shiva Paintstiks.

Fabrics for you to bring:

- 1) One small piece of dark green (forest-like) fabric – hand dyed, batik, painted, or just interesting
- 2) One small piece of printed flowers you can fussy cut wildflowers or greenery (you just need a couple of inches of this)
- 3) Rock cliff and rock fabrics, along with a ground or grassy hill fabric.
- 4) Some white and/or opalescent sheer or transparent fabrics such as white sparkle organza, white shimmer pearl or opalescent organdie
- 5) Small pieces of blue and/or white fabric for water, possibly water print, but any blue and white fabrics will do for the stream underlying sheer fabrics.

Other stuff - required:

- Gluestick
- A couple of sheets of Lite Steam a Seam II (not regular Steam a Seam II, make sure it is LITE!)
- One piece of tracing paper (the kind you see through to trace designs)
- One square foot of freezer paper
- One square foot of fabric for back of quilt
- Scotch tape
- One package of “white” Angelina fiber
- Lots of glass headed straight pins
- Ultra fine line permanent marker
- Palette & a few small paintbrushes, or 5-6 small plastic cups
- Apron
- White plastic garbage bag
- Matches, a taper candle and candle holder, small pan that will hold water
- Olfa cutter, small cutting pan that will hold water
- Paper & Fabric Scissors, including sharp embroidery scissors

- Old metal cookie sheet
- Sewing machine is optional, but desirable. If you can, bring your machine to sew everything down before it slips away. If you plan to do this, also bring .004 mm clear invisible thread, your open toe foot and your darning foot, with neutral thread for the bobbin.

Bring these if you have them already, but do not buy them especially for the class.

- Heat gun and/or hair dryer and/or wood burning tool.
- Parchment paper
