Supply List

This little cutie uses a variety of piecing techniques to learn the ins and outs of minis. You will be doing some paper piecing and learning short cus techniques to create with accuracy.

- Sewing machine and basic sewing supplies
- Rotary mat, cutter and ruler, (Omnigrid 4" or 4 ½" square & 4" x 8" recommended,); 6 x 12 optional)
- ¼" foot
- Thread, embroidery weight cotton, Mettler 60/2 or DMC
- New needle 70 universal or sharp
- Mechanical pencil
- Empty bobbin
- Silk pins and/or clippies recommended
- Stiletto, helpful (optional)
- Straight stitch throat plate (optional)
- Clover or other small iron & pad, helpful (optional)

Fabric,

- 100% cotton, please pre-size the fabric. (Spray with sizing, not starch and press)
- Try to choose small prints or tone on tone
- Choose a variety of lights, mediums and darks for the piecing. 8 – 10 different fabrics. Some stripes could be used. Small amounts, at least a 10" square for some. Just bring some fat quarters or large scraps.
- Inner border, flying geese, dark – fat eighth
- Inner border, flying geese, light – fat eighth
