Description: 63" x 70"

Learn how to dive into improvisational piecing, but in an organized way. Students will create their own crazy pieced fabric, then give it some structure when they make their own Facets quilt top.

Special Equipment

Rotary cutter with new blade and cutting mat (approximately 18" x 24")

Creative Grids Triangle Squared Ruler

Creative Grids Perfect Rectangle Ruler

Acrylic ruler, at least 6" x 12"

Neutral colored 100% cotton thread for piecing (I recommend Aurifil 50 weight)

Sewing machine in good working order with ¼" seam guide

Basic sewing notions – sewing machine if applicable, seam ripper, pins, scissors, etc.

Fabric Requirements for Quilt Top

28 Fat Eights or approximately 3 ½ yards of assorted scraps for blocks

Or assorted precuts (jelly rolls, charm packs, layer cakes) to total this amount

2 7/8 yards white solid for background

1 1/8 yards of red solid for binding
