Strips and Salsa Pattern Supply List: Good for Beginner Level Quilters

A fun quilt to put together using strips from your stash or a Jelly Roll. Accurate cutting and piecing will be emphasized. You can make it fit any bed just by adding blocks to the rows or rows to the quilt. This geometric design goes together using just three blocks. The horizontal version shown small on the cover is an alternate layout that uses similar yardage as the Lap Size.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS for Strips and Salsa Pattern:

	CRIB SIZE	LAP SIZE	TWIN SIZE
2.5" STRIPS	14 Strips	24 Strips	35 Strips
Strips need to be at least 41" long of usable fabric, not measuring selvages.			
Background	1.75 yards	2.75 yards	3.75 yards
Binding	½ yard	2/3 yard	¾ yard
If using Fat Quarters instead of precut strips make sure that they have at least 18"x 21" of usable fabric			
Assorted FQ's	4 FQ's	7 FQ's	10 FQ's

Strip to Shore Pattern Supply List: Good for Beginner to Advanced Quilters

A great geometric design that comes in 4 sizes and is made with 2.5" strips cut from your stash or use a jelly roll! You will need a specialty ruler to finish this quilt. Learn to use either a Creative Grids Hexagon Trim Tool, 60 degree Triangle ruler or a Hex N More ruler. Light or Dark background add interest and variety to your fabric choices.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS for Strip to Shore Pattern:

	CRIB SIZE 45" x 52"	LAP SIZE 54" X 58"	TWIN SIZE 72" X 89"	QUEEN 90" X 95"
Assorted Fabrics 2.5" x 42" STRIPS	28 Strips	39 Strips	84 Strips	112 Strips
Fabric A: Background, Sashing, & Binding	1.5 yards	2 yards	3.5 yards	4.5 yards
Backing	2.5 yards	2.75 yards	5.5 yards	7 yards
